**Lent Reminders**

When you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, so that you may not appear to be fasting, except to your Father who is hidden. And your Father who sees what is hidden will repay you. Mt. 6:18

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.

**What does it mean to fast?**

According to Canon Law, the law of fasting allows only one full meal and two small meals a day.

**What does it mean to abstain from meat?**

According to Canon Law, the law of abstinence forbids the use of meat.

Roman Catholics who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from meat. Disabled, feeble or pregnant nursing mothers are exempt.

**Why should we fast?**

The earliest and most often cited purpose of fasting is penance-that is, atonement for sin. Through fasting we humble ourselves before God - setting aside that which sustains us and gives us pleasure-and turns us toward our merciful Lord.
