Lenten Reminders

When you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, so that you may not appear to be fasting, except to your Father who is hidden. And your Father who sees what is hidden will repay you. Mt. 6:18

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence.

What does it mean to fast? According to Canon Law, the law of fasting allows only one full meal and two small meals a day.

What does it mean to abstain from meat? According to Canon Law, the law of abstinence forbids the use of meat. Roman Catholics who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from meat. Disabled or feeble, pregnant nursing mothers are exempt.

Why should we fast? The earliest and most often cited purpose of fasting is penance-that is, atonement for sin. Through fasting we humble ourselves before God – setting aside that which sustains us and gives us pleasure - and turns us toward our merciful Lord.

A SPECIAL PRAYER

The Canon Law of the Church requires every bishop, on his 75th birthday, to submit his letter of resignation to the Holy Father. Last month, our Archbishop, Cardinal Roger Mahony, reached his 74th birthday. As we look ahead to next year, Cardinal Mahony and the Council of Priests ask the faithful of the Archdiocese to join them in the recitation of this special prayer for the guidance of the Holy Spirit in the Church's selection of the Cardinal's successor:

“Lord, God, you are our eternal shepherd and guide. In your mercy, grant to the Archdiocese of Los Angeles a shepherd who will walk in your ways and whose watchful care will bring us your blessing. In your love for us, give us the joy of receiving a shepherd who will be an example of goodness to your people and who will fill our hearts and minds with the truth of the gospel. We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.”
